It gives me great pleasure to announce the launch of the Hindu Elders Housing Scheme at Broughton Atterbury, Milton Keynes. The scheme is part of a unique concept which will integrate sixty seven housing units with the Milton Keynes Hindu Association's Community Centre. The construction is well under way and when completed it will offer high quality homes for rental or on a shared ownership basis for Hindu elders.

MKHA has worked closely with the developers, Luminus Group, English Partnerships and Milton Keynes Council to bring to you this long awaited project. We will be assisting Luminus with the nominations for the homes and enclose with this letter is a message from Mr Chan Abraham, the Group Chief Executive of Luminus, introducing the scheme.

Luminus have put together an information pack with full details of how to rent or purchase a home in the development. *To receive your copy of the information pack you must return the tear off slip and send it to Luminus in the envelope provided.* We anticipate a high demand for these homes and I would ask you to register your interest as soon as possible. The slip must be returned by 30 September 2007.
